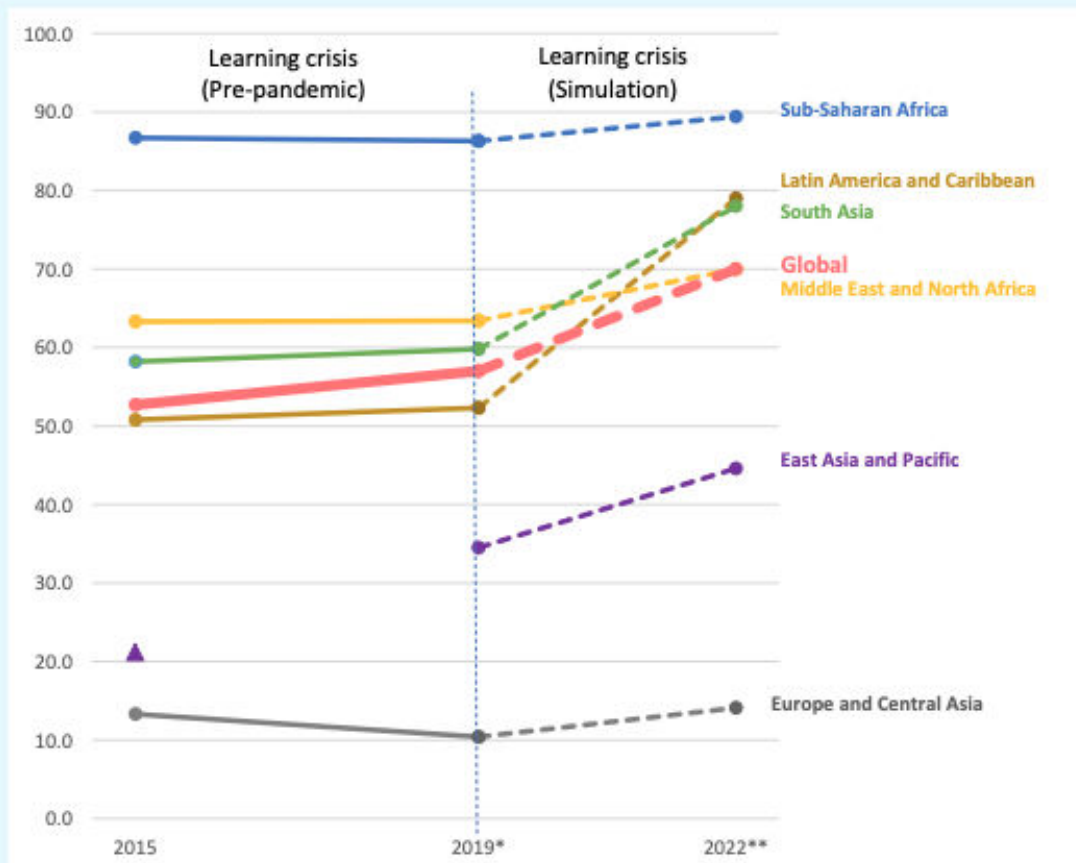


Figure 1. Learning Poverty Globally and by Region—2015 and 2019, with 2022 Simulation Estimates
